

Stay the Duck at Home
26 Fryers Street

This mural was created by Shepparton artist Tank in April 2020. It references the lockdowns and stay at home orders we experienced due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.



Reflections of Kaiela, Woka, Yedabilla, Danam
GOTAFE
Corner of Fryers Street and Corio Street

The title translated to English means Reflections of Rivers, Land and Fauna. The mural was completed in September 2019 by students, their trainers and street artist George Manioudakis aka manofdarkness.

ABORIGINAL STREET ART



Some of the murals in Shepparton’s CBD celebrate and recognise local Aboriginal history and culture.

Well-known artist Matt Adnate’s works at 104 Fryers Street (next to GV Water) and at 172 Welsford Street depict the late William Cooper and the late Pastor Sir Douglas Nicholls KCVO OBE, MBE, Aunt Margaret Tucker (MBE) and Nanny Nora Charles, and Aunt Geraldine Briggs and Aunt Elizabeth Morgan.



Cam Scale’s mural at 70 Welsford Street recognises local Aboriginal people who represented Australia in war, and pictures Private Daniel Cooper, a Yorta Yorta man killed in action during World War I. He was just 21 years old and is buried in Belgium. Daniel Cooper was son of Yorta Yorta man Uncle William Cooper and Agnes Hamilton.

TATURA



Tatura Mosaic Murals
Stuart Mock Place

Depicting the history, development and future of Tatura, this mosaic mural emphasises the importance of Sun, Earth and Water.



Tatura Museum Mural
49 Hogan Street

Depicting the Internment/POW Camps that existed in the area during World War 2. This mural is on the Ross Street side of the Tatura Irrigation and Wartime Camps Museum.



Tatura Water Tower
83 Ross Street
Artists: Cam Scale & Andrew Davis

The Tatura Water Tower was designed by General Sir John Monash in 1912. In 2021 his portrait was painted onto the water tower, with remembrance poppies on the other side.

LEMNOS



Campbell's Soup Can
55 Lemnos North Road

The Campbell's Soup Factory opened in Shepparton in 1962 and shortly after the water tower was painted to resemble the iconic Campbell's Soup Can, made world famous by the iconic pop artist Andy Warhol, whose prints of the soup cans were released the very same year.

DOOKIE



Dookie Nomadic Silos
Mary Street & Tallis Wine, 195 Major Plains Road

A silo trail with a twist, featuring sizeable artworks created by local and international artists on an assortment of upcycled, decommissioned, portable grain silos.

Designed with a distinctive point of difference, the works are nomadic in nature – created on moveable, transportable, relocatable grain bins that can be grouped together or separately.



Dookie Flowering Sugar Gum
Mary Street

Located in Mary Street, this beautiful old gum blossoms with a flourish of 150 large spectacular red flowers. Symbolising regeneration, optimism and inspiration, Dookie is celebrating the transformation and new life of its iconic sugar gum.




